ABOUT FASHION MODA

Fashion Moda was an art gallery and performance space in South Bronx, New York. As a museum of science, art, invention, technology and fantasy from 1978-1993 it combined aspects of a community arts centre and a worldwide progressive arts organization. Fashion Moda was founded in 1978 by Stefan Eins. He was soon joined by artist Joe Lewis and William Scott, a young teenager from the neighborhood as co-directors. Defining itself as a concept, Fashion Moda quickly became a strong voice in the New York art world during the late 1970s and the 1980s.
